1. Submit a **New Student Application** and appropriate **supporting documentation** through the Accessible Information Management (AIM) Portal to begin the accommodation request process.

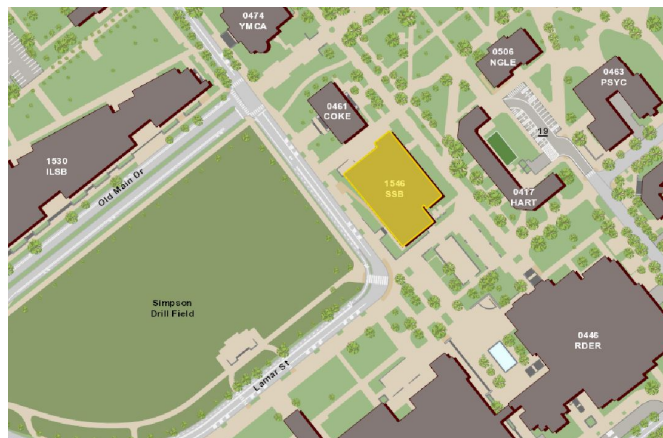


2. After the request information is reviewed, an Access Coordinator will contact the student to discuss the request and/or to schedule an appointment to discuss potential accommodations.
